Our Lake Forest chancel choir, our handbells, and our musicians set to music the extravagant love expressed in the birth of our Savior. As we join our voices with theirs, and as we bask in the special music that will fill our church during Advent, may the joyful sounds invite our hearts to once again come and see the Greatest Gift, The Christ Child Who came to make His dwelling among us.

Weekly rehearsal schedule:

- Handbell Choir rehearses each Wednesday night at 6 p.m. Our handbells will play in the 10:45 a.m. worship service on Sunday December 18 and then be on break from rehearsals until February 2023.
- Chancel choir rehearsal is on Wednesday nights at 7 p.m. The choir will rehearse on December 7 and 14 at 7 p.m. and then be on break until January 11 at 6:30 p.m. All January rehearsals will be at 6:30 p.m.
- Planned childcare is now provided for children of our chancel choir members while they rehearse.

Our choirs will not rehearse on Wednesday, December 21, Wednesday, December 28 or Wednesday, January 4.

For the past several years at Christmas we have partnered a non-profit organization, the Unicorn Fund, to provide shoebox gifts for needy families. The Unicorn Fund is going through a restructuring period as they seek new leadership. As a result they will not be collecting shoebox gifts. So our Session has decided our special giving emphasis for December will be to once again receive a **Birthday for Jesus Offering** to help eliminate our shortfall in our yearly budget. Throughout the month of December all offerings designated to the Birthday Offering for Jesus as well as any loose offerings



collected will go to this deficit reduction effort.

A non-profit organization in our community that our Lake Forest church family has partnered with for several years is the FISH Hospitality Panties. Volunteers at the FISH pantries work year-round to provide food and other essential items to our neighbors in need right here in South Knoxville.

Please bring cans of soup, cans of chili, and canned fruit with you as you come to church and place them in the large plastic bins that are located in the narthex and the gallery.

These items will be donated to the FISH pantries to help feed families during the holidays and throughout the coming year.
