

Rev. Wyn Bryant, who has become a familiar face in our supply pastor rotation, has accepted our call to be our Part Time Interim Pastor. Rev. Bryant has been a member of the Presbytery of East Tennessee since he was ordained in 1980, except for one year when



he was a member of the Presbytery of San Francisco. Originally from Texas, he graduated from "the other UT" and attended seminary with his dear friend, the late Rev. Judd Shaw. Since 1989, he has worked as what is sometimes called a "tent maker;" serving small congregations in East Tennessee while working as a technical editor on projects in Oak Ridge. He has served us here at Lake Forest on many Sundays throughout our season without a pastor and he already feels like part of the Lake Forest church family. He and his wife, Judy, have five children and four grandchildren. Our church family is so thankful that God has led Rev. Bryant to serve us in this season and we look forward to enjoying his ministry and friendship in the weeks to come as he joins us on this journey of transition.

Rev. Bryant plans to keep office hours on Wednesdays or Thursdays but can be reached at any time on his cell phone or by email.



- Viewing an archived video of our worship service, found on our Facebook page.




Our 10:45 a.m. worship service streams live each Sunday morning on the church's Facebook page.




is taking a break for the summer!


